

OFFICIATING A VIRTUAL SWIMMING AND DIVING MEET

ALL THE DUAL-MEET RULES AND PROCEDURES (including the Covid Safety ones) WILL APPLY, EXCEPT FOR THE FOLLOWING CHANGES:

There will only be one team swimming and diving. Their opponent will be in a different location. Maybe at the same time – maybe not. The pool size and timing system being used do not involve or concern us.

The home team's pool will determine the number of lanes scored in the meet. If both coaches agree, teams may use the same number of lanes at each pool for scoring purposes.

Exhibition swimmers and divers will be permitted but should be noted on entry cards. All rules regarding athlete, participation and conduct apply.

Breaks for both teams must take place during the same points in the meet for the same amount of time.

If you are working the location by yourself:

You will serve as the referee, the starter, the stroke and turn judge, and the diving referee.

After judging the diving score, the score should be tripled. When you sign the Diving Scoresheet, also write on the sheet that there was only one diving judge. The diver will be exhibition and it should be so indicated on the scoresheet and the results.
